Qualifications for above posts shall be as per the UGC regulations 2010 as shown below:

PROFESSOR:

- i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/ allied /relevant discipline; published work of high quality; actively engaged in research, with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- ii) A minimum of 10 years of teaching experience in University / College and/ or experience in research at the University/ National level institutions/industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology enabled teaching-learning processes.
- iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal system (PBAS), set out in the UGC (4th Amendment) Regulations, 2016.

OR

An outstanding professional, with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned / allied / relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

In such cases of selection of Professors who are from outside the academic stream and are considered under this the University Syndicate shall lay down clear and transparent criteria and procedures so that only outstanding professionals who can contribute substantially to the university knowledge system are selected.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR:

- i) Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned / allied / relevant disciplines.
- ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and / or research in an academic / research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution / industry, excluding the period of Ph.D. (only for full time scholars), research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and / or research / policy papers.
- iv) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-enabled teaching-learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- v) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal system (PBAS), set out in the UGC (4th Amendment) Regulations, 2016.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR:

- i) Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in above one and two sub-clauses, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, or the subsequent Regulations if notified by the UGC, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.
- iv) Those who are, or have been awarded Ph.D. Degree prior to 7-11-2009 shall exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for requirement and appointment in the cadre Assistant Professor or equivalent position in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

Those who have obtained Ph.D. degree after 11.07.2009 must have completed Ph.D. with course work.

- v) Further the award of degrees to candidates registered for the M.Phil./Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing ordinances/By laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degrees and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the recruitment of the minimum eligibility condition of "NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-
 - a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
 - b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
 - c) Candidate had published two research papers out of which at least one in a refereed journal from out of his/her Ph.D. work;
 - d) The candidate had presented two papers in seminars/conferences from out of his/her Ph.D. work;
 - e) Open Ph.D. viva-voce of the candidate had been conducted.(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor/Dean(Academic Affairs)/Dean (University Instructions)"
- vi) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/ SLET/ SET is not conducted.

The applicants while applying must strictly adhere to the UGC (Minimum qualifications for appointment teachers in Universities and Constituent Colleges) Regulations, 2010.

In case of the MBA the candidates who possess Ph.D. Degree in accordance with UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009/NET/ SLET/ SET are eligible.

4. Demonstrated leadership in planning and organizing academic, research industrial and /or professional activities; and
5. Capacity to undertake /lead sponsored R&D, consultancy and related activities.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR:

DESIRABLE:

1. Teaching research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
2. Published work, such as research papers, patents filled / obtained, books, and / or technical reports; and
3. Experience of guiding the project work / dissertation of PG / Research Students or supervising R&D projects in industry.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR:

DESIRABLE:

1. Teaching research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or refereed journals.

EDUCATION: (As per NCTE)

PROFESSOR:

- i) A Master's Degree in Arts /Humanities/Science/Commerce and M.Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed),

OR

M.A. (Education) with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and B.Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade system in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)

- ii) Ph.D. in Education; and
- iii) At least ten years of teaching experience in University Department of Education or College of Education of which a minimum of five years at the M.Ed. level with published work in the area of his Specialization.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR:

- i) A Master's Degree in Arts /Humanities/Science/Commerce and M.Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed),

OR

M.A. (Education) and B.Ed. with a minimum 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)

- ii) Ph.D. in Education; and
- iii) At least Eight years of teaching experience in University Department of Education or College of Education of which a minimum of three years at the M.Ed. level and has published work in the relevant area of his Specialization.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR:

- i. A Master's Degree in Arts /Humanities/Science/Commerce and M.Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed),
OR
M.A. (Education) and B.Ed. each with a minimum 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed); and
- ii. Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC / such other affiliating body / State Government, from time to time for the positions of Principal and Lecturers, shall be mandatory.

Provided that, it is desirable that one faculty member possesses a Master's Degree in Psychology and another member in Philosophy / Sociology besides M.Ed.

COMPUTER SCIENCE:

Qualifications as mentioned under the title Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor.

Preference will be given to the candidates with Ph.D./NET/SLET/SET. However, in the absence of this, the selection shall be in accordance with AICTE Norms.

MUSIC, PERFORMING ARTS, VISUAL ARTS AND OTHER TRADITIONAL INDAIN FORMS ETC.

Qualifications as mentioned under the title Professor, Associate and Assistant Professor.

- i. Good Academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level, in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/Foreign University.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC. like SLET/SET.
- iii. Notwithstanding anything contained in the sub-clauses (i) and (ii) to this clause 7.2, candidates, who are, or have been awarded Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent position in University/Colleges/Institutions.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall also not to be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

OR

A Professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have:

- a) First class Diploma in Visual (Fine) arts discipline from the recognized Institution of India /Abroad.
- b) Five years of Experience of holding regular regional/National exhibitions/Workshops with evidence; and
- c) Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

MANAGEMENT/ BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION:

Qualifications as mentioned under the title Professor/Associate Professor and Assistant Professor.

Essential:

- i) First Class Master's Degree in Business Management/ Administration in a relevant management related discipline or first class in two years full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / accredited by the AICTE / UGC;
- OR
- ii) First Class graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant /Cost and Works Accountant/Company Secretary of the concerned statutory bodies.

Desirable:

Teaching, research, industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization; Papers presented at Conferences and /or published in refereed journals.

EXPERIENCE OF TEACHING MEANS:

Service rendered in College/ University on a full time basis & in approved UGC Pay Scales or other Government Scales and duly certified by the head of the institution will be considered as teaching experience

Part-time/temporary assignments (e.g. Guest faculty) are not considered for the purpose of computing the teaching experience.

MODE OF SELECTION:

The list of selected candidates will be prepared as per the Government of Karnataka Notifications:

1. No. DPAR 13 SBC 2001 dated 21.11.2001
2. No. SWD 47 STC 2004 dated 09.05.2005

RURAL CANDIDATE:

- Candidates claiming reservation under rural category should have studied and passed from 1st to 10th std in rural areas governed by prevailing rules relating to reservations and shall produce a certificate in Form No. 2 issued by the competent authorities.

EX-SERVICEMEN:

- Candidates belonging to Ex-Servicemen category have to produce necessary certificates issued by the competent authorities.

Note: The candidates, who have applied in response to our earlier notifications, need not apply. None the less, they can send their updated bio-data if any in 8 sets to the undersigned before the last date.

OTHER CONDITIONS:

1. Candidate must possess the required qualification before the last date prescribed for the receipt of application.
2. 'Service rendered in College/University' means 'Service rendered in Degree College/University'.
3. The certificates pertaining to SSLC or Equivalent Examinations/ Transfer Certificates/Cumulative Records wherein the date of birth is mentioned should be enclosed.
4. As per Government Order No. ಸಕಇ 251 ಬಿಸಿಎ 94 dated 31st January, 1995 the candidates belonging to SC/ST, Category-I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB, are required to produce the copies of the declaration certificates in the prescribed forms for employment purpose issued by the competent authorities who are empowered to issue such certificates in support of their claims and copies of the School Leaving Certificates along with their applications. Such certificates should not have been issued earlier than **ONE YEAR** by the concerned authorities empowered to do so. Please note that Caste Certificate issued by only Tahasildar/ Assistant Commissioner of the concerned jurisdiction of the ordinary residence of the applicant will be valid.
5. SC/ST candidates will be considered as per Go.No.BC-16014/1/ 82 SC & BCD-1, dated: 6-10-1984. A relaxation of 5% of marks is provided for SC/ST/Differently-abled for the purpose of eligibility.
6. The University has the right to alter the roster/ conditions if mistakes are found in the classification subsequently to the issue of notification.
7. Appointment to the posts may be permanent depending upon nature of the vacancy and the requirement of the University. In such case, they will be on probation for a period of two years according to the rules of the University.
8. Every Professor, and Associate Professor appointed shall execute a service agreement to the University signed between the candidate and the University.
9. Candidates selected for the above said posts are liable to be posted to work either at P.G. Centre, Jnanagangothri, Chitradurga or at any other Post-Graduate Centre established in future.
10. Candidates who are in service shall send their applications through their employer on or before the last date prescribed, failing which their applications will not be considered.
11. The copies of the publications and true copies of testimonials/ Certificates/ Caste Certificates/ Statement of Marks/ Service Certificate should be enclosed to all the eight sets, which will not be returned.
12. The application and processing fee is not refundable under any circumstances.
13. Separate applications are to be sent for each post.
14. All belated, incomplete and not in the prescribed form applications in eight sets and without payment of processing fees will be rejected and no further correspondence will be entertained in the matter.
15. Canvassing directly or indirectly will disqualify the candidate.
16. The right either to fill or not to fill the above posts advertised is reserved with the University.
17. The appointments will be made, as per the rules in force.

18. The right to select or disqualify the candidates is reserved with the University. No further correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
19. Part-time/temporary assignments (e.g. Guest faculty) are not considered for the purpose of computing the teaching experience.
20. A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
21. The Ph.D. Degree shall be a mandatory qualification for the appointment of Professors and for promotion as Professors.
22. The period of time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and /or Ph.D. Degree as full time scholars shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions.
23. A minimum of 300 points and 400 points score in the API based PBAS as prescribed in Annexure-I are required under direct recruitment of Associate Professors and Professors respectively.
24. Consolidated API score for the posts of Professor and Associate Professor are 400 and 300 points from category III respectively.
25. Candidates who do not fulfill the conditions required for the post need not apply.
