The Community Development Centre of Department of Social Work, Davangere University, Davangere, had conducted an awareness campaign, Free Food Kit distribution and distribution of masks at the University adopted Villages viz. **Kurki, Hiretogaleri, Chikkathogaleri, Bullapura & Hanumanahalli** and some of the measures were taken for safeguarding Senior Citizen women from COVID-19. Davangere University has adopted five villages under village adoption scheme at Kurki, Hiretogaleri, Hanumanahalli under Kurki Grama Panchatyath. 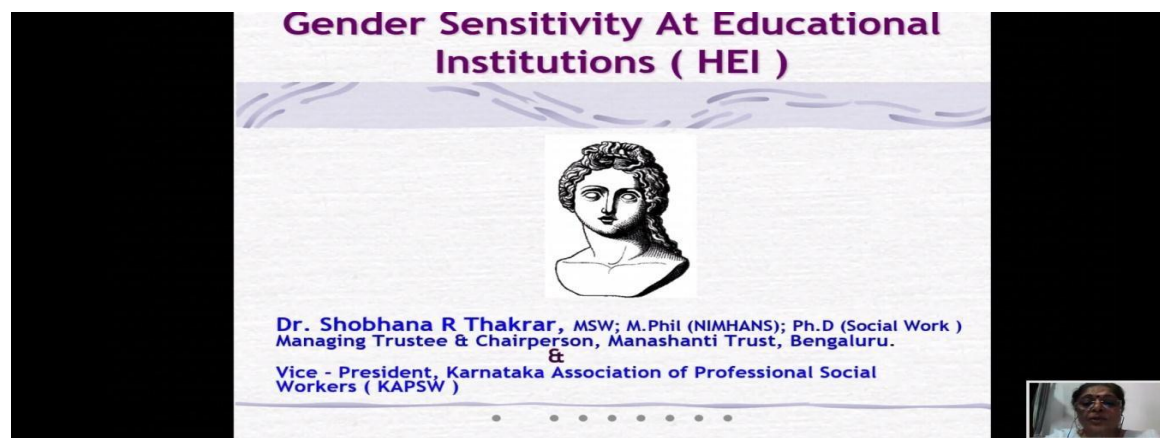

(Prevention, Prohibition & Redressal) Act - 2013



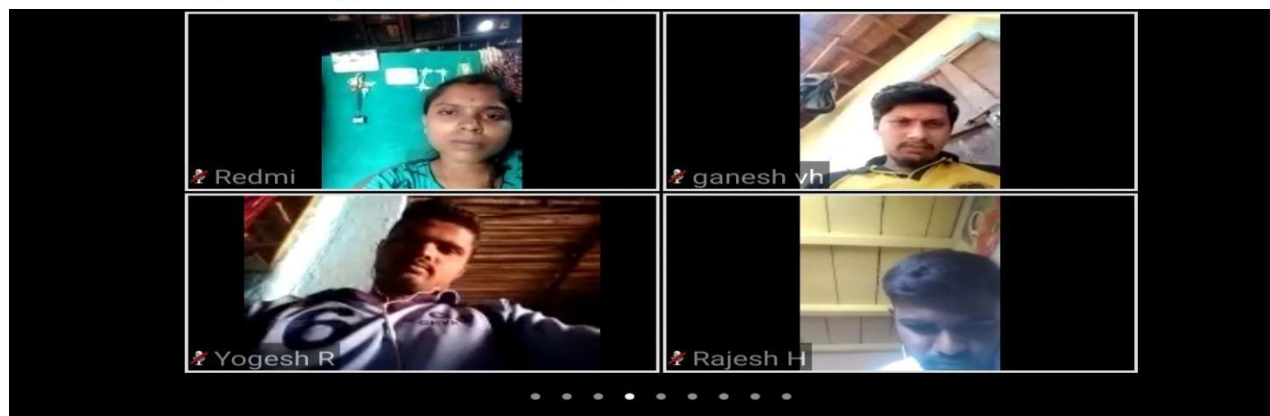
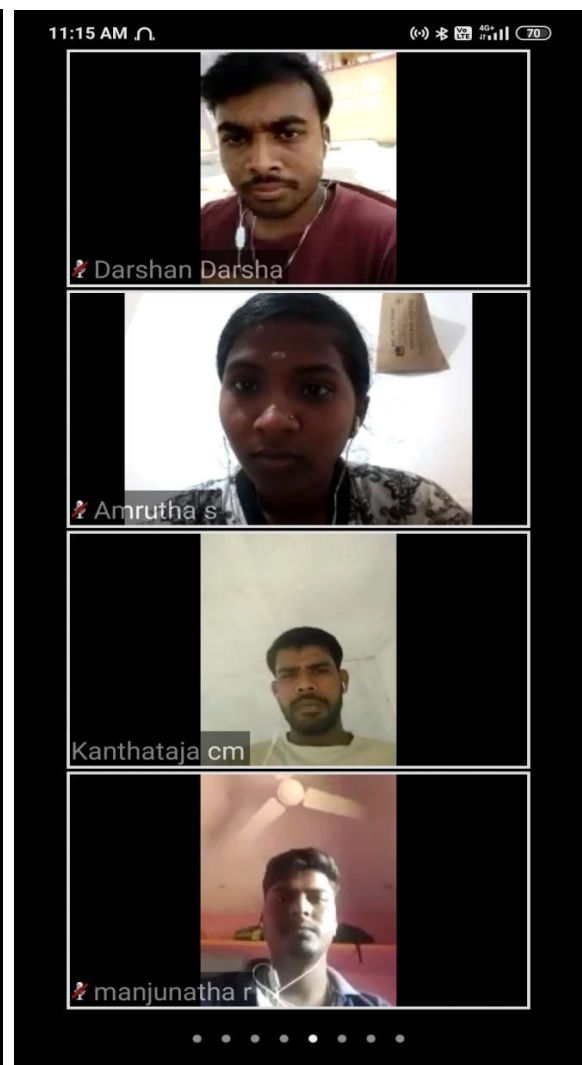
