





The following areas were covered in the lecture:


- 1. SHWW Act-2013 and UGC Regulations-2015; Prevention, prohibition and Redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher education

There were many clarifications sought by the faculty and students after the presentation and the resource person could able to give lot of insightful incidents in her clarifications.

















Report on Gender sensitization programme conducted on November 4th2020


