

## About Davangere University

Davangere University is one of the youngest affiliating type of Universities in Karnataka. It has a jurisdiction of two Districts viz., Davangere and Chitradurga and headquartered at Davangere. ## About the workshop

Research and teaching are two complementary areas of academic endeavour. A good researcher must possess scientific rigour in observation and analysis and a well-read updated approach to a particular subject and towards the society in general. In that line, a good teacher must primarily be a good researcher. In this backdrop, often it is found that bogged down by the daily routine of teaching and evaluation in academic institutions, a disjuncture often happens between teaching faculties and their updated research orientation. Moreover, young teaching faculties also require guidance in managing classes, its ethical conduct with an equitable approach. Therefore research and teaching together forms the backdrop of building overall capacity of an academicians. In social science disciplines in India, opportunities are very rare for faculties to get updated knowledge on techniques of social science research and ethical conduct of classroom teaching with a mixed approach to research methodologies.

Given the new regulations of teaching learning and evaluation standards set up by UGC, New Delhi, it is extremely important on the part of young faculties to write good research papers on their respective subjects. Having training on the updated knowledge of their respective subjects, the general technicalities of writing a good research paper with proper reference style is a *sin qua non* for every faculty members which is lacking due to proper guidance on such technicalities. It is also important for young and middle age-group faculty members to submit proposals for minor and major research projects and a prior knowledge about designing of such a project proposal is a prerequisite. A good research paper and/or a research proposal has its own syntax and techniques which needs to be grasped by the faculties. The current trend is, towards adopting scientific techniques in putting forth their analytical point and one such important technique is statistical package for social science or SPSS. It requires simple training for understanding the commands for SPSS software.

In this context, the objectives of this programme are to develop capacity for conceptualising and writing research proposals. Enhance skills to prepare an appropriate research design, including conducting a literature review, formulating research questions and hypotheses, collection of information and analysis. Enhance capacity for writing a research paper for publication. Develop the capacity for planning and writing a book. Develop the capacity for grant applications, the training programme strives to highlight some emerging philosophical and methodological issue emerging in social science research. The programme will inculcate discussions on formation and selection of a research problem, design of research, sampling

techniques; tools of research; collection of data; analysis of data, interpretation and discussion of results and report writing. The aim of the training programme is to enable the participants to select and make use of suitable research methods; to use appropriate research tools and to analyse their research questions with appropriate analysis of data in their research. Most importantly, one must be able to summarise the analysis in an appropriate manner and write them coherently, an art which needs an expertise and is a learning experience.

## Objectives

The objectives of the proposed CBP programme are as follows:

- to make young faculties understand the linkage between teaching and research
- to ensure dissemination of last knowledge on teaching and research
- to enhance the capacities of young faculties and researchers in social science in teaching and research
