- 3. The Course Director is required to strictly follow the terms and conditions including the budget allocation as clearly mentioned in the ICSSR TCB guidelines which are available at the ICSSR website www.icssr.org (copy of budget enclosed)
- 4. The institution may re-appropriate expenditure form one sanctioned sub-head to another subject to a maximum of 10 percent. All such re-appropriations should be reported to the ICSSR. Proposals for appropriations, which exceed 10 per cent of the amount sanctioned for any item shall require the prior approval of the ICSSR.
